CHO Youngtae (Ph.D) has been a professor of demography at the Graduate School of Public Health at Seoul National University(SNU) since 2004. Currently, he serves as the director of the SNU Population Policy Research Center. Professor Cho and his research team's academic interests include the fundamental cause of the lowest low fertility in Korea, measuring and analyzing a new concept of population (presenting population), the impact of population dynamics on future market change, and demographic dividend issues for Vietnam and Indonesia. He achieved his Ph.D., specializing in demography, from the University of Texas-Austin in 2002. He served as a member of the Presidential Committee on Ageing Society and Population Policy, and a member of the National Economic Advisory Council.
